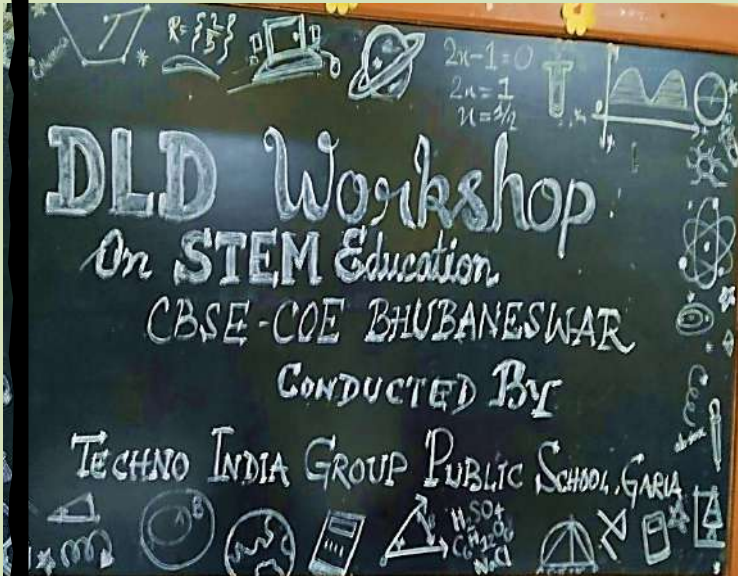

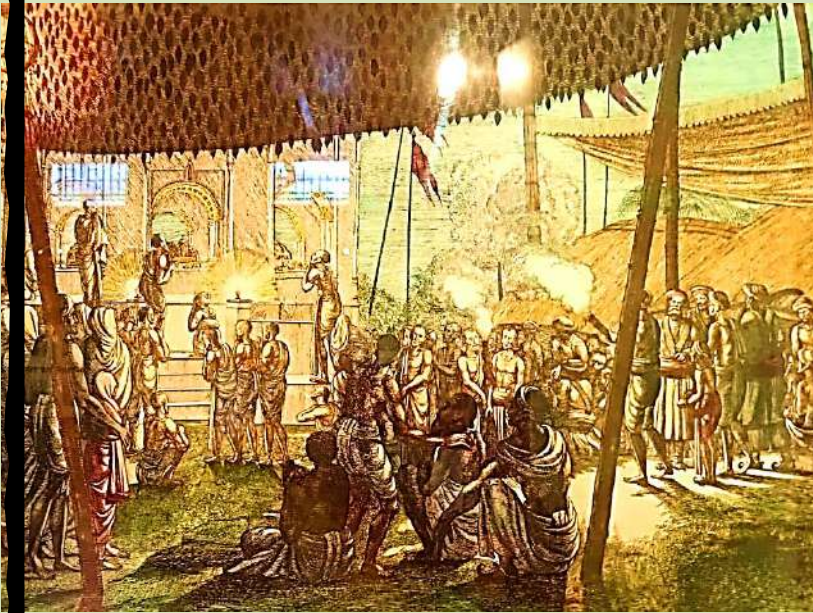

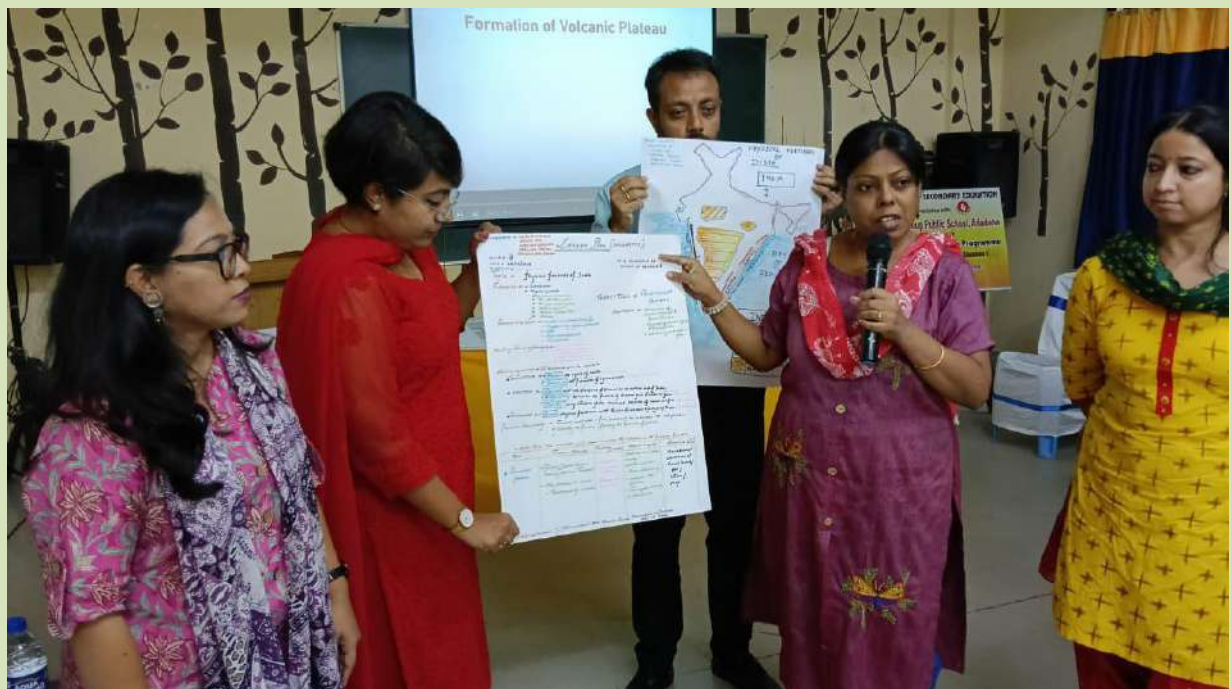

Session 5 was again activity based where the participants were divided into groups based on the subjects and asked to prepare a model lesson plan for a period of 40 mins and demonstrate that.



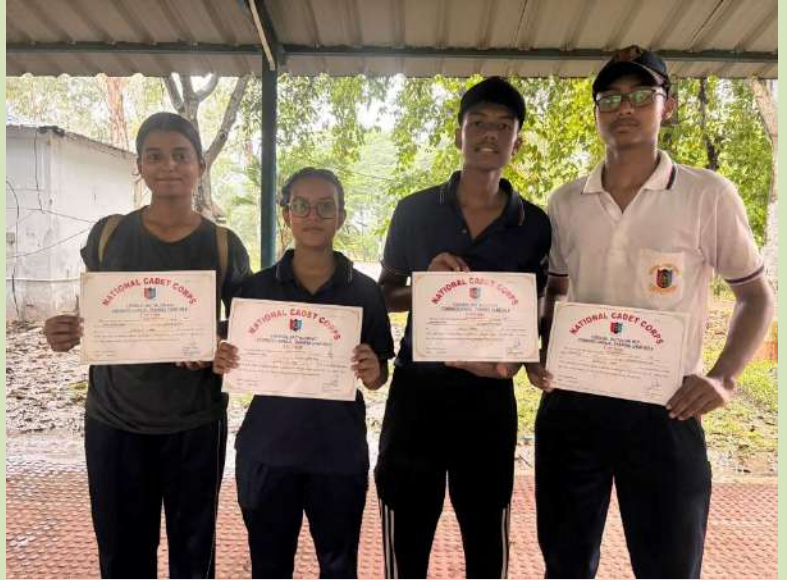
NCC CATC CAMP KB-6
