Empowering Teaching and Learning with AI and chat GPT

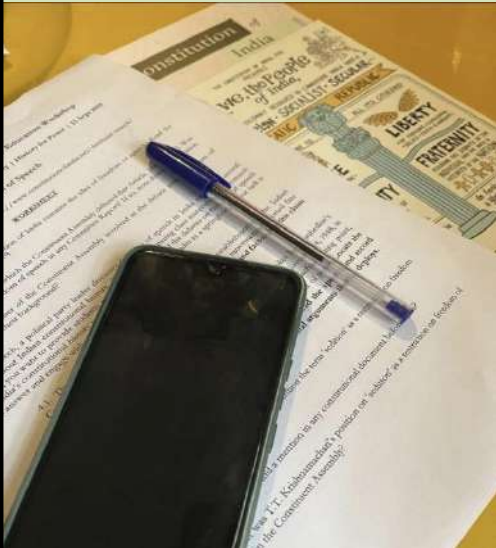

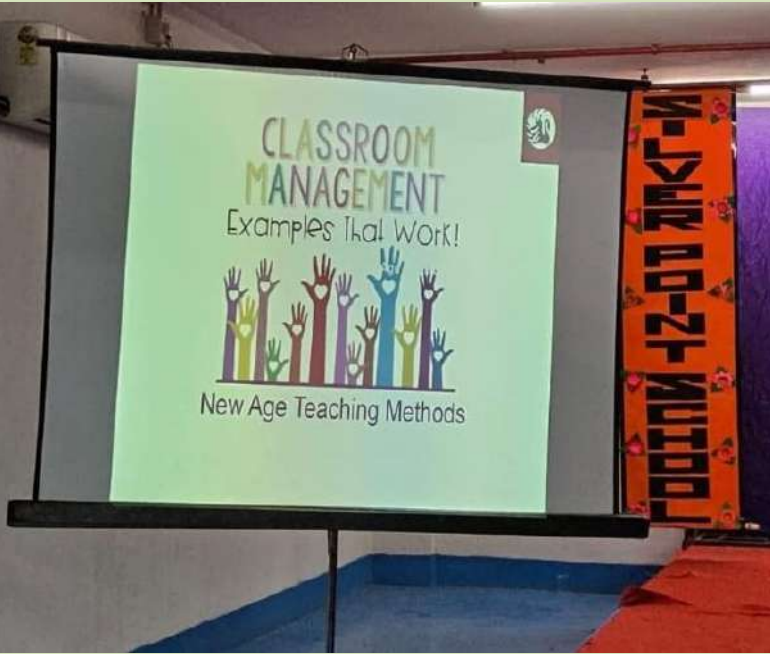
Report on Classroom Management Workshop

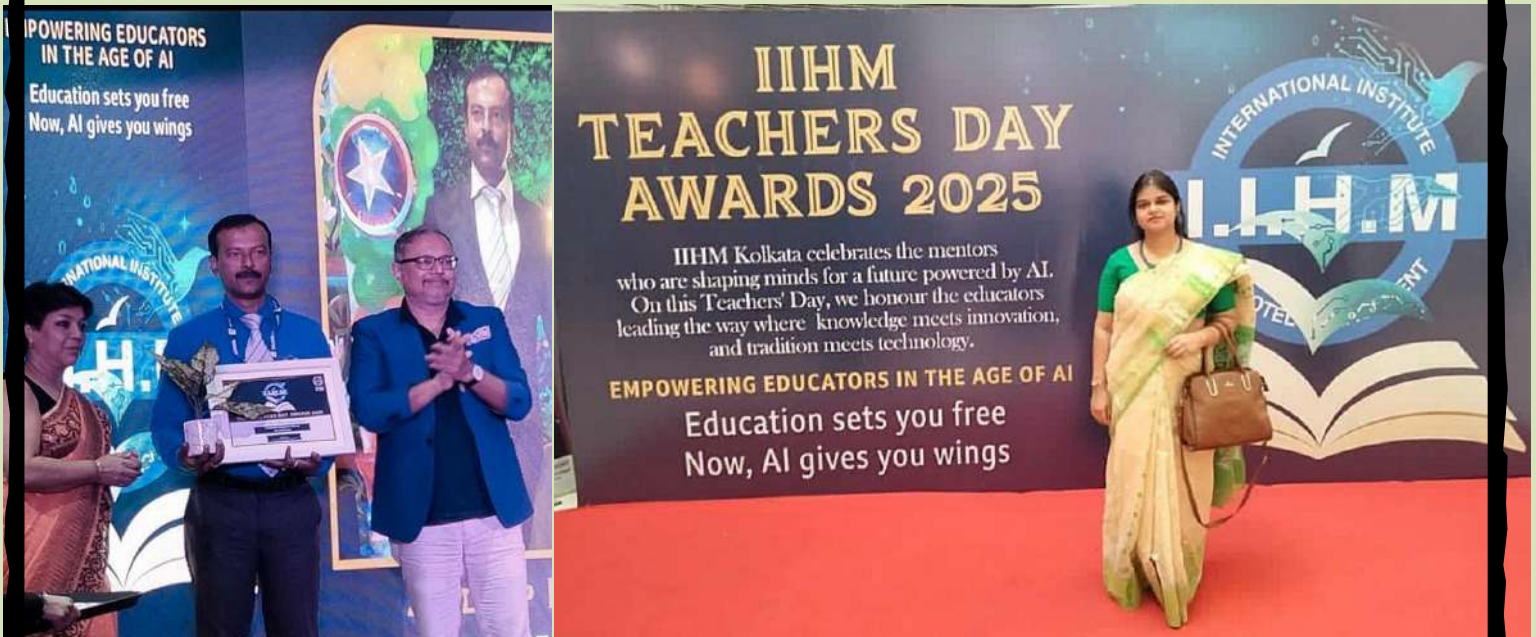
Teachers' Day Award Ceremony.

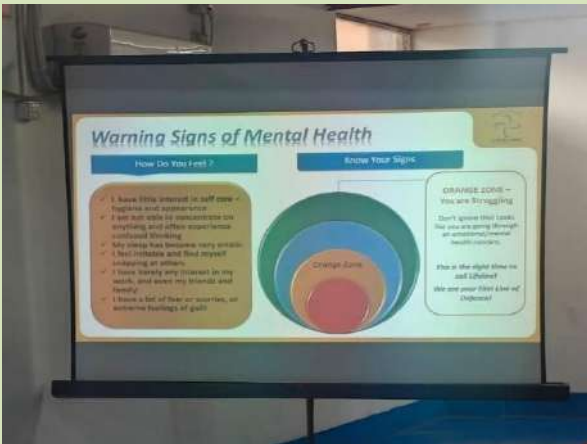

World Peace Day Celebration

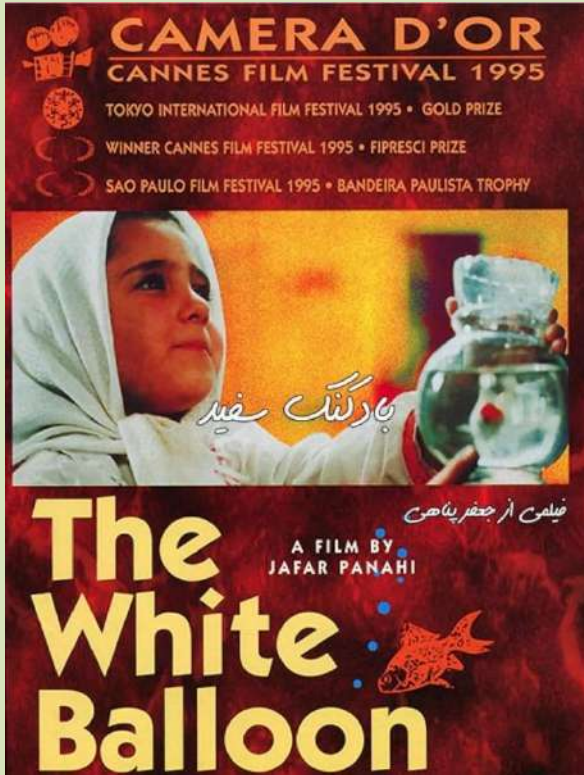
