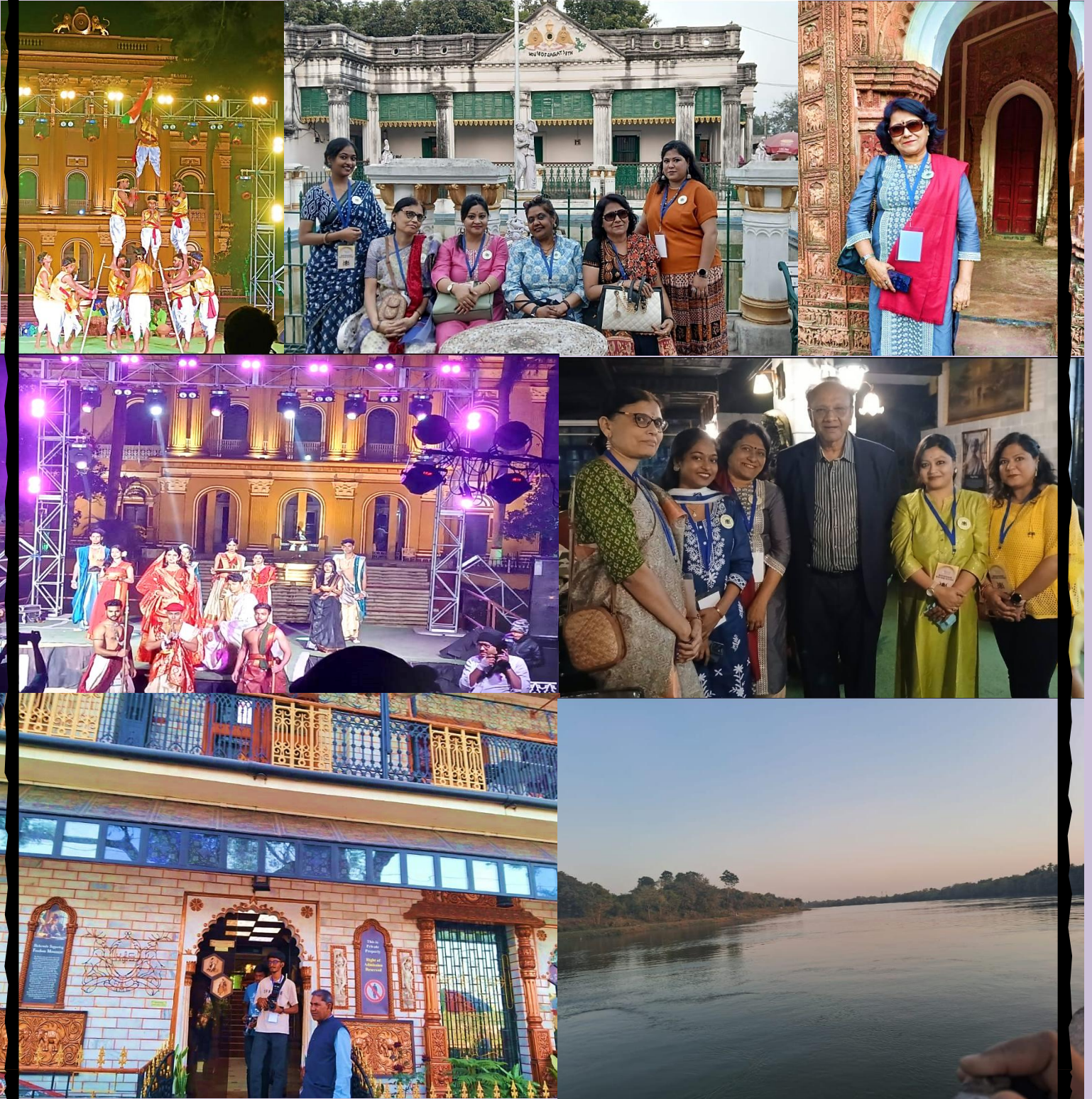


## A Heritage Trip to Murshidabad

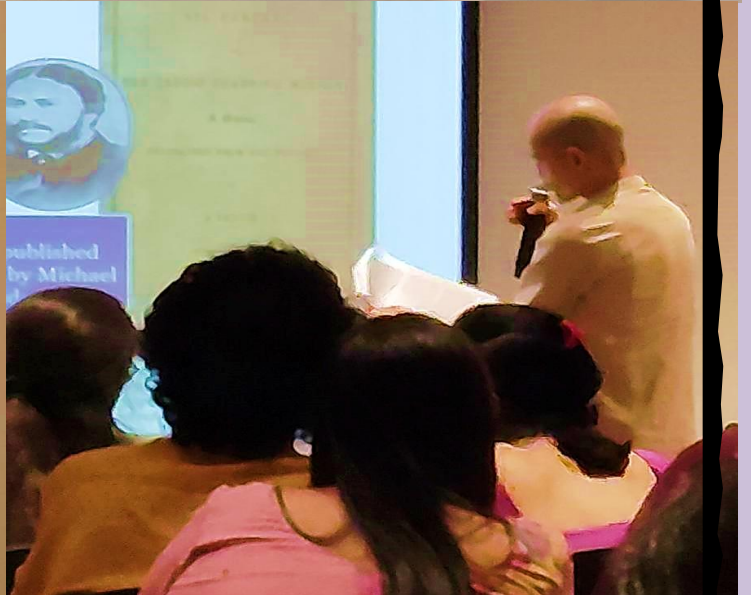
