The programme commenced with the Welcome Speech by Ishu Singh of class 11 Science and the display of colourful posters depicting LABOUR DAY and its significance.



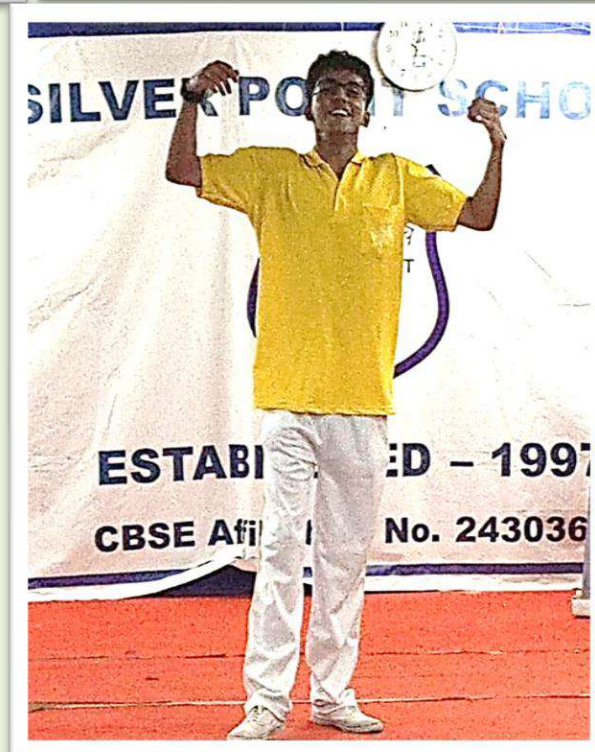
Laughter Day Celebrations.
